## HEALTHY NEW YEAR

Reminder from Chicago Department of Public Health: Protect Yourself from Respiratory Illness This Season

Chicago is seeing increases in viral respiratory infections and hospitalizations, including COVID-19, flu and RSV.

Hospital admissions levels are "Medium" CDPH recommends that individuals:

- Stay up to date with COVID-19 vaccines.
- Maintain ventilation improvements.
- Avoid contact with people who have suspected or confirmed COVID-19.
- Follow all isolation guidance if you have suspected or confirmed COVID-19.

If you are at high risk wear a high-quality mask or respirator (e.g., N95) when indoors in public.

- If you have household or social contact with someone at high risk for getting very sick, consider self-testing to detect infection before contact, and consider wearing a high-quality mask when indoors with them.

(CDPH) immunization clinics provide vaccinations for children 0 through 18 years of age at no out-of-pocket cost. COVID-19 and flu vaccines are available to all. Find another vaccination provider, <http://vfc.illinois.gov/search/>

**FREE COVID TESTS** Every home in the U.S. is eligible to order 4 free at-home tests beginning November 20. If you did not order tests this fall, you may place two orders for a total of 8 tests. <https://special.usps.com/testkits>
