FREE COVID TESTS FROM THE GOVERNMENT ARE BACK-HERE'S HOW TO GET YOURS

On September 25, U.S. households can order four free tests through COVIDTESTS.GOV. The tests can detect all currently circulating COVID-19 variants, including EG.5, the dominant variant in the U.S. right now. The tests are intended for use through the end of 2023 and will include specific instruction on how to verify expiration dates. For more information – 1-800-232-0233.

LIHEAP

LIHEAP helps eligible households with low income pay for home energy services. This includes

electricity. Deadline: The LIHEAP application period is October 2, 2023, to August 15, 2024, or until funding is exhausted. The program will begin taking applications on October 2, 2023, for seniors (age 60 and older), disabled and families with children under the age of 6 years old. On November 1, 2023, households that are disconnected from their utilities/energy vendors, have a disconnection notice or have less than 25% in their propane tank can start applying for LIHEAP assistance. All other income eligible households can start on December 1, 2023.
