### SENIOR SERVICES AT A GLANCE

Information and Assessment is key to determining which city services and programs are available for senior citizens and eldercare service providers. Central Information and Assessment is in City Hall with five community locations in each regional senior center. This assessment will determine eligibility for many city services including, but not limited to, home delivered meals, medical transportation assistance, senior companion program, legal assistance, senior housing information, caregiving resources, employment services, and life enrichment programs. ### PROBLEM WITH RACOONS

- Secure trash can lid. Use a rope, chain, or bungee cord to tie the lid into a secure position
- Clean out rash cans. Wash them out with the hose often. Sprinkle the inside with baking soda to remove any lingering omnivores, so they will not pass up any pet food, feed your pets indoors
- Identify points of entry. Inspect your house,

garage, and fence. Look for holes 3 inches in diameter or bigger.

 Use a solution to repeal raccoons from entry points and nesting areas. Boil one cup of cayenne pepper and 3-5 chopped habanero chilies with water in a pot and let it cool. Transfer it into a spray bottle. Spray the entry points you have identified.
