WALK UP COVID-19 TESTING IN 60619

On Friday, August 14, CCC is partnering with CORE, A Hand to Give and Park Manor Christian Church to host a FREE COVID-19 Testing Site at 8330 South King Drive between 10:00 a.m.-4:00 pm. This is a non-painful mouth swab and you will receive results in 3-5 days. No ID required. You should not eat/drink/smoking 20 minutes before taking the test. Pre-Register for reduce wait time at chicagocovidtesting.com. All are encouraged to get tested. CCC will be giving away cloth masks to adults and children at this event.

On August 1, CCC gave away more than 3500 cloth masks, hundreds of hand sanitizers, and distributed absentee voter mail applications.
