WHERE TO GET INFORMATION ABOUT THE COVID-19 VACCINE

The State of Illinois entered phase 1B and opened eligibility for the vaccine to residents 65 years or older, or who are frontline workers. If you would like more information about the vaccine or to make an appointment, please contact the Illinois Department of Public

Health at <https://covidvaccination.dph.illinois.gov/> or call 833.308.1988. You will be prompted to take a screening survey that will walk you through the process.

CARJACKING AND THEFT

Chicago has averaged more than 6 per day since January 1st. Elected officials and law enforcement hosted several online meetings to share safety tips, law enforcement efforts and education on how the court system will handle those arrested (many are 15-20 years-old). Most of these cars have been found abandoned within a few days. If you are a victim or a witness call 911 immediately. STREET WORK & DRINKING WATER

Work is happening on water and sewer lines on King Drive -Cottage Grove on 91st Street. Water quality may be a problem from the disturbed pipes. There are no safe levels of lead. The City recommends we run the cold water from any faucet for 5 minutes every time it has been stagnant for 6 hours or more, to flush the lines. Use a water filter that is clearly labeled Certified to Remove Lead (brands like Zero Water or PUR). The City of Chicago offers some free water filter pitchers and filter coupons if there is a water meter.
