Caregiver Respite provides a break from caring for loved ones. A variety of options include in home care-home care aides, hiring of a friend or family, and residential care in a facility. Support is available for up to two weeks annually.  
Grandparents or older relatives aged 55+ who have primary responsibility for a child under 18 or loved one with severe disabilities aged 19-59 are eligible for services including one-on-one or family counseling, support groups, information and referrals, education opportunities, and more.
