EARLY VOTING – MARCH 17, 2026 PRIMARY ELECTION

Any registered voter in Chicago may vote at **any Early Voting site**, regardless of their ward or precinct. Voters may choose the location most convenient for them, including on Election Day. All Early Voting sites are ADA-compliant and fully accessible to voters with disabilities. Early Voting Dates and Locations:

- March 2 – March 16, 2026 (for the March 17, 2026 Primary Election)
 - o Whitney Young Library – 415 E. 79th Street (6th Ward)
 - o Olive Harvey College – 1001 S. Woodlawn Avenue (8th Ward)
- March 2, 2026: Early Voting begins at all 50 Ward locations across Chicago.
