ILLINOIS MARIJUANA USE & SALE LAW – HIGHLIGHTS (source WLS-TV-11/14/2019)

When will marijuana be legal in Illinois? January 1, 2020

Who will be able to purchase marijuana legally?
Adults aged 21 and over

How much marijuana can be legally purchased or possessed? Up to 30 grams, or about one ounce, of marijuana plant material, edibles totaling no more than 500mg of THC, and five grams of cannabis concentrate products.

Can I grow my own marijuana? Only medical marijuana patients will be able to grow plants at home.

They are limited to five plants.
Will I be able to smoke wherever I wants? No, you will not be able to smoke marijuana in public legally. Consumption in private residences will be legal.
What about people in jail for marijuana? The law allows for people convicted of possession of under 30 grams prior to legalization to have their records referred to the Prisoner Review Board and the Governor for a pardon. Cook County State's Attorney Kim Foxx office will expunge all misdemeanor marijuana convictions once it becomes legal.
