SIDEWALK SNOW REMOVAL

According to the City of Chicago Municipal Code

“Every owner, lessee, tenant, occupant or other person having charge of any building or lot of ground abutting upon any public way or public space shall remove the snow and ice from the sidewalk...”

It is everyone’s responsibility to make sure the sidewalk is clear of snow and ice. If you do not own your residential or business property, consult your rental agreement, lease agreement, or management company to determine your shoveling obligation.
