## COVID-19 VACCINE SITE IN OUR COMMUNITY ON JULY 17

CCC in conjunction with St. Mark Lutheran Church, and Roseland Hospital will host a vaccination site at the church located at 655 East 88<sup>th</sup> Street. Roseland Hospital will be administering the Pfizer Vaccine on Saturday, July 17, 11:00 am – 3:00 pm. Please encourage the unvaccinated to attend. ## Frequently Asked Questions:

Question -Do I need to wear a mask and avoid close contact with others if I am fully vaccinated

No. Fully vaccinated people can resume activities without wearing a mask or physically distancing, except where required by federal, state, local, tribal, or territorial laws, rules, and regulations, including local business and workplace guidance. If you are fully vaccinated, you can resume activities that you did before the pandemic.

Question– If I have already had COVID-19 and recovered, do I still need to get vaccinated with a COVID-19 vaccine?

Yes, you should be vaccinated regardless of whether you already had COVID-19. That is because experts do not yet know how long you are protected from getting sick again after recovering from COVID-19. Even if you have already recovered from COVID-19, it is possible—although rare—that you could be infected with the virus that causes COVID-19 again. Studies have shown that vaccination provides a strong boost in protection in people who have recovered from COVID-19.
