Scammers are using Illegal robocalls to pitch everything from scam Coronavirus treatments to work-at-home schemes. The recording might say that pressing a number will let you speak to a live operator or remove you from their call list, but it might lead to more illegal robocalls, instead.

Fact-check information. Scammers, and sometimes well-meaning people, share information that has not been verified. Before you pass along on any messages, please contact trusted sources.

Contact tracers from the Health Department will not ask you for a social security numbers, banking or credit card information.
