HOW TO GET RID OF RACCOONS/POSSUMS (source wikiHow)

Method 1 – Cleaning up and removing attractants

1. Check the areas around your home and clean up all the garbage, dog/cat fleeces, food, paper, food, berries that fell from trees.
2. Keep garbage cans clean and free from smell by washing them out with the hose every so often.

Method 2 – Removing access points

1. Identify points of entry. You're looking for holes 3 inches in diameter or bigger.
2. Close off (use ½ inch/1.3 cm metal meshing then hit it with a foam gun) all points of entry

except the one you think they use most.
3. Soak up 3-5 tennis balls with ammonia and throw them inside and around the places you think they're nesting.
