This a portion of city ordinance 7-28-120

Any person who owns or controls property with the city must cut or otherwise control all weeds on such property so that the average height of such weeds does not exceed ten inches. Any person who

violates this subsection shall be subject to a fine of not less than \$600 not more than \$1,200.
